

## *Directions to Camp Hamwi*

### **STEP ONE – HEAD TO DANVILLE, OH**

---

#### **From Akron:**

Travel Interstate 76 west to Seville. In Seville take State Route (SR) 3 south through Creston, Wooster, and Craigton to Loudonville where you stay on SR 3 south to Jelloway. At Jelloway turn south (left) on Rte. 205 to Danville. In Danville turn left on to SR 62.

---

#### **From Cincinnati:**

Travel north on Interstate 71 to Columbus. Take 270 east around Columbus to the exit for SR 161 east through New Albany. In New Albany, turn left on to SR 62 heading north through the towns of Johnstown, Utica, Martinsburg, and Millwood until you come to Danville. (Approximate distance 173.3 miles)

---

#### **From Columbus:**

Travel 270 east or north to the exit for SR 161 east through New Albany. (If you miss the exit for SR 161, there is an exit for SR 62 to New Albany south of it.) In New Albany, turn left on to SR 62 heading north through the towns of Johnstown, Utica, Martinsburg, and Millwood until you come to Danville. (Approximate distance 62.7 miles)

---

#### **From Dayton:**

Travel east on Interstate 70 to Columbus. Take 270 north or east around Columbus to the exit for SR 161 east through New Albany. In New Albany, turn left on to SR 62 heading north through the towns of Johnstown, Utica, Martinsburg, and Millwood until you come to Danville. (Approximate distance 140.4 miles)

---

#### **From Toledo:**

Travel Interstate 75 south to Findlay. South of Findlay take SR 15 east to SR 23 south. In Upper Sandusky, take SR 30 east through Bucyrus and Crestline to Mansfield. In Mansfield, take Rte. 39 south or east through Perrysville to Loudonville where you take SR 3 south to Jelloway. At Jelloway turn east or south (left) on Rte. 205 to Danville. In Danville, turn left on to SR 62. (Approximate distance 154.0 miles)

---

### **STEP TWO – DANVILLE TO CAMP (18744 Turkey Ridge Road)**

From Danville to Camp Hamwi

At the intersection of Rte 514 and SR 62 where there is a gas station on one corner and a bank across the street, turn east on SR 62 and travel about 2.8 miles to Camp Mohaven/Camp Hamwi sign. Turn left on to a dirt/stone road (Pritchard). Travel approximately 1.3 miles down this road until you come to a stop sign. At the stop sign, turn right onto Turkey Ridge Road, and go about one mile to the entrance of camp. Go in the second stone gate (the one with the Indian). The first drive is exit only. Park in one of the designated areas in order to keep the road open for traffic. Follow the road back to the Main Lodge where registration is held on the front porch.

**DO NOT try to enter camp directly off State Route 514; that is a logging road and you will get stuck.**
